PSHE



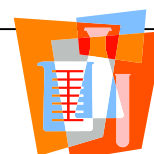
- Health and well being – Growing and Changing – Keeping safe

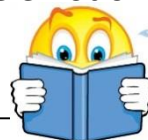
Theme: The Classics
