- Residential.

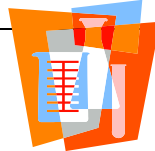
SCIENCE

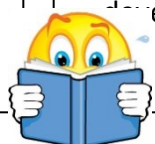
Theme: The Hunger Games
