- Lesson once a week.



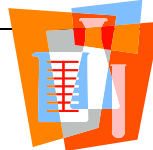

'Charlotte's Web' by E.B. White and 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake.

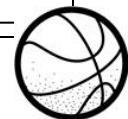
- organising paragraphs around a theme in narratives, creating settings, characters and plot
