



The policy below sets out the expectations in the home/school agreement outlining the roles and responsibilities of the school, the child and the parents. We take steps to ensure that all registered parents of pupils sign the agreement to indicate that they have understood and accept the home-school agreement. The Head teacher will meet with Reception pupils and parents at the beginning of the academic year to sign the home-school agreement. The head teacher will also meet with parents of pupils who have transferred to our school.

AS A SCHOOL WE WILL

- Care for your child's safety and happiness.
- Contact you if there is a problem with attendance, punctuality or uniform.
- Let you know of any concerns about your child's learning or behaviour.
- Offer guidance and support to encourage home learning.
- Provide as much information as possible on all aspects of your child's school life, learning and progress
- Provide an environment where your child can be an active learner within a wide variety of experiences.

Homework

- Set achievable homework (differentiated where applicable) to extend the curriculum and provide the opportunity for independent learning. Clear information will be given alongside so parents/carers can support their child if required.

Learning Environment

- Provide your child with a high standard of education, implanted by national guidelines, within a balanced curriculum.
- Ensure that our learning environment is stimulating and challenging.
- Celebrate your child's academic achievements.
- Provide the scaffolding needed to enable your child to reach their full potential.
- Care for your child's safety and well-being by observation and listening to them.

AS THE PARENTS/CARERS WE WILL

- Ensure that our child attends punctually and is properly dressed in school uniform and equipped with PE kit and reading book.
- Let the school know any reason for absence as soon as possible.
- Let the school know any reasons, which might affect our child's behaviour and learning.
- Support the schools values regarding behaviour and discipline
- Support and encourage our child's learning at home and at school.
- Keep in touch with all aspects of our child's life at school by reading letters returning slips and attending meetings.

Homework

- Support the school by ensuring that homework is completed and returned on time.
- To use your expertise, knowledge and talents to extend your child's learning at home.

Learning Environment

Make sure my child arrives at school by 8.50am

- Make sure my child is wearing named school uniform or other suitable clothing and that their PE kit is brought into school at the beginning of each week.

AS THE PUPIL WE WILL

- Bring all the things I need every day
- Wear school uniform and be clean and tidy
- Do all my class work and homework as well as I can
- Be polite, helpful and supportive to others
- Look after the school and its property
- Keep the school rules.

The school will review the home-school agreement when they see fit and before adopting any changes all parents of registered pupils will be consulted before changes are implemented.

As well as following the guidance set out in our Home-School Agreement, we expect parents, carers and visitors adhere to the code of Conduct for Parents and visitors.
